DEFINITIONS USED IN THIS DOCUMENT

- “Site” refers to the website www.rockstarpr.co.uk.
- “We”, “our”, or “us” refer to Rockstar PR.
- “You” or “your” refers to the user of the website.

1. WHO WE ARE AND HOW TO CONTACT US

- 1.1. We are Rockstar PR, a music public relations and social media consultancy. We are the owners and providers of the Site

2. ABOUT COOKIES

- 2.1. A cookie is a file which contains a unique identifier that is sent by a server to your browser and is then stored by your browser. The unique identifier is sent back to the server each time your browser requests a page from the server.
- 2.2. Cookies can either be “persistent” or “session” cookies.
 - A persistent cookie will be stored by your browser and will remain valid until its expiry date, unless you delete it before the expiry date.
 - A session cookie will expire when your session ends and you close your browser.
- 2.3. Cookies may not contain any personal information that identifies you, but personal data that we store about you may be linked to the information that is stored in and obtained from cookies.

3. COOKIES THAT WE USE

- 3.1. We use cookies for the following purposes:

Necessary

Necessary cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies

Name	Details	Expiry
CookieConsent	Stores your cookie consent state for the current domain	1 year
local_storage_support_test	The cookie is used in context with the local-storage function in the browser. This function allows the website to load faster by pre-loading certain procedures	Persistent

Marketing

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors across websites. The intention is to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third party advertisers.

Name	Details	Expiry
test_cookie	Used to check if your browser supports cookies	1 day
IDE	Used by Google DoubleClick to register and report the your actions after viewing or clicking one of the advertiser's ads with the purpose of measuring the efficacy of an ad and to present targeted ads to you	1 year

Statistics

Statistics cookies help website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously.

Name	Details	Expiry
UTMA	Collects data on the number of times you have visited the website as well as dates for the first and most recent visit. Used by Google Analytics	2 years
UTMB	Registers a timestamp with the exact time of when you accessed the website. Used by Google Analytics to calculate the duration of a website visit	1 day
UTMC	Registers a timestamp with the exact time of when you leave the website. Used by Google Analytics to calculate the duration of a website visit	Session
UTMZ	Collects data on where you came from, what search engine was used, what link was clicked and what search term was used. Used by Google Analytics.	6 months
UTMT	Used to throttle the speed of requests to the server	1 day

Preferences

Preference cookies enable a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in.

Name	Details	Expiry
Lang	Remembers your selected language version of a website	Session

4. COOKIES USED BY OUR SERVICE PROVIDERS

- 4.1. Our service providers use cookies and those cookies may be stored on your computer when you visit our website.

- 4.2. We use Google Analytics. Google Analytics gathers information about the use of our website by means of cookies. The information gathered is used to create reports about the use of our website. - 4.3. We publish Google AdSense advertisements on our website. The advertisements may be personalised to reflect your interests. To help determine your interests Google and its partners use cookies. The relevant cookies served from our website are ads/ga-audiences. The cookies are used to track your previous visits to our website and your visits to other websites.
